Special Timeline

SPRING classes END Tuesday April 28, 2009 and SUMMER classes officially begin Tuesday May 26, 2009.

DYNM 753/754 will meet at least once before departure between April 28 and May 14 on a date TBA.

Course travel will take place between as follows:

Depart New York to Beijing:	Friday 15 May 2009
Fly from Beijing to Shanghai:	Saturday 23 May 2009
Return Shanghai to New York:	Saturday 30 May 2009

DYNM 753/754 will meet upon return from China on at least one Monday evening with date TBA.

Tuition

DYNM 753/754 is valued at 2 course units (CUs). Tuition is as follows:

Note: Tuition is per student based on single occupancy (each person has a single room). A discount of up to \$900 may be available if a hotel room is shared while in China. See reservation form for more information.

Tuition Includes:

- All course books, readings and program materials
- All meals associated with classes held at Penn before and after travel
- All airline costs: Flights from New York (JFK) to Beijing, Beijing to Shanghai, Shanghai to New York (JFK) with Air China. Fuel surcharges are included (valid at the time of the proposal)
- All airport taxes in US and in China
 - Approximately, \$158/ per person right now plus, RMB 90 airport user fee when departing China (30 May 2009) on international flights and RMB 50 airport fee for the domestic flight within China (23 May 2009).
- All accommodations:
 - 7 nights hotel accommodation at the **Crowne Plaza Hotel** in Beijing. Hotel taxes, service charges, and daily breakfasts are included.
 - 7 nights hotel accommodation at the **Equatorial Hotel** in Shanghai. Hotel taxes, service charges, and daily breakfasts are included.
- All airport/hotel transfers In China
- Transportation from Penn campus to JFK (depart) and from JFK to Penn campus (return)
- Welcome Beijing dinner at the **Quanjud Peking Duck Restaurant with transfers**
- Farewell Shanghai dinner at the **Lubolang Restaurant with transfers**

Tuition Does Not Include:

- Optional Tours
- Personal expenses, tips, meals not included in the academic program abroad
- Optional Travel Insurance (\$199 extra per person if desired)

Airline Flights

DYNM 753/754 tuition includes ALL airline flights from the US to China, from Beijing to Shanghai, and from Shanghai to the US. By including these costs in the group travel program, the cost of the hotels and other logistics are reduced.

Organizational Dynamics Academic Grants

An academic grant of up to \$1500 per person is available for Organizational Dynamics degree candidates who attend DYNM 753/754. The amount of the grant will be applied directly to a student's account to offset the total tuition invoiced for this program.
